GOULD SWIM ACADEMY UPDATE - TERM 4 2018

LAST WEEK - 10TH TO 15TH DECEMBER - SAFETY WEEK:

*ALL morning, afternoon and Saturday (15th) lessons shall have safety activities and will be required to wear pyjamas in the pool and leave their goggles at home please.

*This is inclusive of all ages and levels.

*Adults are not required to wear pjs in the water with their littlies.

*The theme shall be the BEACH so please talk about safety aspects of beach activities with your children.

*Please do not underestimate the value of Safety Week as we have had numerous reports of children having used skills learnt during this week.

TERM 1 2019 - STARTS MONDAY 4TH FEBRUARY:

Most schools will start the week before however we shall start the first FULL week. Be prepared to swim on Monday 4th February. This is a ten week term. Term 1 shall finish on Saturday 13th April.

TERM 1 ENROLMENTS:

All CURRENT Term 4 enrolments shall be rolled over so you will be automatically enrolled for Term 1. Please advise us if you will NOT be swimming. Please let us know if you need to change days for next term. We operate at capacity so it is important that you communicate promptly with us.

TERM 4 INVOICES:

Must be finalised no later than Saturday 15th December. Any unpaid accounts shall result in your child/ren not being enrolled for Term 1. Reminders shall be emailed Monday 3rd December. Thank you to the families with payment plans for keeping on track and up to date.

HOLIDAY INTENSIVE PROGRAM:

Week One starts 7th January;

Week Two starts 14th January;

Week Three starts 21st January.

This is a 30 minute lesson each day, Monday to Friday, with two children per class at a cost of \$105 each. You may do one, two or

three weeks. We have left messages with most families on our Contact List. Please respond NOW if you have a missed call from 60400400. This program is open to all, you don't have to be a regular at GSA to get in. We have limited places and they are filling very fast!! This is a great opportunity to have lessons if you don't swim during the term; improve particular skills; get in some practice and skill refinement for the school carnival.

TERM 1 INVOICES:

The invoices shall be bulk emailed in early January. Please READ the invoice for your class day/time, term dates and other relevant info. We have payment stipulations stated on the invoice regarding paying the invoice or arranging a payment plan. Please note that these will be enforced.

INSTRUCTOR CHANGES:

Please note that during the end of this term and into Term 1 we shall have a few instructor changes. Therese is on bed rest as she awaits the arrival of her first born in January; Annette is due to have a knee operation next week; Alisha is moving into a new field; some will be heading to uni next year; others will be finishing uni and moving on. We have been busy training some new instructors and we welcome them to our team. Our staff roster will be determined in the new year. We ask for your patience and understanding in this process. Whilst change is difficult at times for some, it is also inevitable in life.

WAITING LIST:

We shall be working through our waiting list late December/early January. Please note that this is a lengthy exercise due to the sheer number on our list. We operate at capacity and rollover our existing classes so any availability is very limited. This term we also move the school-starters from morning to afternoon classes for 2019. If you have a missed call from our number then it may be in your best interest to reply ASAP. We make an effort to contact everyone on our list to advise if we have availability or not. If you wish to be taken off the waiting list at any stage then please advise us.

NSW ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHERS:

We shall continue to accept the vouchers in Term 1. This will be a new calendar year and you shall be entitled to a new voucher for 2019 for

each school-aged child. You shall have until 31st December 2019 to use the voucher. We will require either a paper copy or emailed copy of the voucher before we can redeem it. You are then responsible to pay the difference on your invoice. If you require further information then research the website https://sport.nsw.gov.au/sectordevelopment/ activekids.

CHRISTMAS GIFTS:

BACK BUBBLES:

We sell the back bubbles! We often have parents wishing to source the back bubbles that we use in our parent/child classes. These are great if you are going on holidays or swimming at home. The layers can be removed as your child gains in confidence and improves in skills. You can pass the back bubble down to the next child in line. \$25 each.

Note: adult supervision is required at all times



CAR PARKING:

Thank you to the families who use our car park located at the back of our building. Please remember to drive extremely slowly in and out of the drive as children obviously frequent the area. When the car park is full we ask that you park on the road. Yes, you may have to walk 30, 40 maybe 50 metres! Be sure to get your child/ren out of the car on the kerb side and use this opportunity to teach road safety. Do NOT park on Braybrook Engineering's front strip. They are entitled to operate their business without being hindered by parked cars on

their property. This includes no parking there on Friday nights, Saturday mornings or anytime you think they may not be working. Do NOT park across Merv's Shed driveways as the owners come and go at varying times and again are entitled to do so without having access blocked.

If you park near the driveway of Frauenfelder Gates then please LEAVE AT LEAST 2 metres either side of the drive for semi-trailers to access the driveway. You will no doubt understand the space a semi requires to turn and if not enough room then you may find your car in danger of being damaged. This business is entitled to operate without being hindered by parked cars blocking access.

Is there something in our facility that you feel is unsafe? Please let us know! We welcome your feedback at any time.
